


Gyprock® Cove Cornice

The simple curved design of Gyprock Cove has made it the standard for Australian builders. This functional profile is available in a range of sizes and creates a gentle transition between the wall and ceiling without making a major statement.

Cornice Manufacture

Gyprock Cove cornice is composed of gypsum plaster encased in a strong linerboard and is manufactured to stringent product specifications.





Installation

Painting and Decoration

Finishes applied to cornice surfaces can have a significant effect on the perceived quality of the installation, particularly where critical lighting conditions exist.

- Matt finishes minimise imperfection visibility
- Semi-gloss and gloss finishes highlight imperfections
- Light colours are less likely to show imperfections

Gyprock recommends paint systems consisting of one coat of a plasterboard sealer followed by two coats of finishing paint. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for application and recoating.

Gyprock recommend decoration in line with Master Painters Australia.
